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Telephone Triage is defined as "making good clinical decisions under conditions of uncertainty and urgency" (Patel). Assessment by phone of an invisible patient, who is an untrained lay observer, complicated by the variability of symptom presentations, communications and process is challenging.

A process for sorting injured people into groups based on their need for, or likely benefit from, immediate medical treatment. The first recorded example of telephone triage was in First documented telephone consultation by a GP (1879). However it is only relatively recently that telephone triage has been recognized as a specialist nursing area. Just as face-to-face patient assessment requires particular skills, patient assessment by telephone can be even more challenging.

Telephone Triage Skills

"The paper reports on some early findings of a major component of the reasoning strategy utilized by nurses when making triage decisions via the telephone. The study reveals that in telephone triage nurses compensate for the absence of face-to-face contact by creating a mental image of the caller and the situation being dealt with.
